Summary: Paragraph Punch® More Effective Than Traditional Ways of Teaching Writing

Freshman English students (N=80) at Al-Balqa University were selected and divided into two groups. The study used a pre-test and post-test control group design. Forty students were taught by using the classical way in the control group and forty students were taught by using Paragraph Punch in the treatment group.

According to Table 2, the mean score of the experimental group (23.75) is higher than the scoring average of the control group (19.18). As seen in the table, the T value (4.232) is statistically significant ($\alpha \le 0.05$). Improvements were shown in aspects of content, organization, vocabulary, language, and mechanics usage.
